

Side Letter Unenforceable: *Darbude v Eurocom Cable Management Bulgaria* (2011)

This case highlights the dangers of entering into so called "side letters" on construction projects. Construction professionals and contractors often attempt to persuade clients/employers to enter into such letters, which are often too uncertain or vague and do not amount to a legally binding contract. If a client intends any side letter/agreement to be enforceable and legally binding, they should first obtain legal advice.
